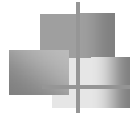

## Five Best Products form 2006

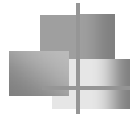


## Five Best Products form 2006

**Non-Beef - Non-dairy diets** - avoiding beef and dairy (which are the most common food allergens in dogs) allows a more lenient food trial with essential fatty acids included in the diet. Owner compliance is improved, and most dogs respond well.

**T8 Keto Solution** - Tris Edta solution with 10mg/ml final concentration of enrofloxacin (see recipe on [UTSkinVet.org](http://UTSkinVet.org) What's New page) is the best treatment for Pseudomonas otitis even if the culture reports resistance to enrofloxacin the high concentration will overwhelm the resistant mechanisms of the Pseudomonas.

*(systemic abx at any dose will not kill Pseudomonas due to its extremely high MICs)*

**EpiOtic Advanced** is a unique otic formulation (new concept) that is neutral pH, non-irritating, eliminates odor, is moderately ceruminolytic, and can kill bacteria and yeast.
